(Guests are greeted by the pastor and are given the opportunity to stand, share their name and make brief comments.)

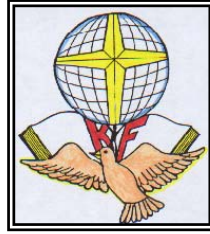
